Standing Order Authorizing
Out-of-County Travel with
Court Designated Child Advocates

Whereas the Court finds:

As part of their duties, Court Designated Child Advocates often become involved in providing transportation for their Advocate Children for visits with parents, siblings, and other relatives, for other activities related to court-ordered services, and for recreational and educational outings, and often, this involves traveling outside Santa Clara County to nearby counties;

It is hereby ordered that:

Minors who are dependents of the court are authorized to travel with their Court Designated Child Advocate anywhere within the "nine bay area counties" (Santa Clara, San Mateo, San Francisco, Marin, Sonoma, Napa, Solano, Alameda, Contra Costa) and the adjacent or nearby counties of Santa Cruz, Monterey, San Benito, Merced, Stanislaus, and San Joaquin, without further approval or action by the court.
